Every time you see a patient you select an ICD-10 code. Sometimes, however, you do not understand that an ICD-10 code carries a certain “value” based on a payment model instituted by CMS back in 2003. It is that payment model “Risk Adjustment Model” that is going to be used in the future to determine your reimbursements (payment for performance.) This score will follow your NPI number forever, regardless of if you are a solo practitioner, in a group practice, or hospital employee.
